These students are only included in the dropout count when specific documentation of the school change is not provided.

**Beginning with data for the 2009-2010 school year, the Colorado Department of Education changed its calculation methodology for graduation rates to comply with federal law. The new methodology only includes "on-time" graduates, or students who complete high school in four years. The change in methodology makes graduation rates for the 2009-2010 school year and beyond not comparable with rates for prior years.

[†]The City of Broomfield became its own city and county on November 15, 2001. Broomfield has not established a school district and is still included under Boulder County school districts.
